(f) Road Rally Class (5) is open to two wheel drive cars subject to a minimum 25,000 production run with the drive configuration as original manufacturers specification. i.e. Front Wheel Drive must stay Front Wheel Drive and Rear Wheel Drive must stay Rear Wheel Drive. The gearbox may be changed

(g) Road Rally Class Tyres

All tyres must comply with Section K22.3.2 MSA Blue Book 2007

(h) All Cars in this class (5) must be taxed as it would be to compete on a night rally No tax No challenge points All cars must carry the necessary safety equipment as required by stage rallies. i.e. Fire Extinguishers, Fireproof Overalls and MSA log book etc. Scrutineers will check eligibility. Advertising and intercoms are allowed.

(i) Engines Cylinder bores may be 60 thousandths of a inch oversize without affecting class eligibility.

(j) Scoring For The Classic Motorsports 2wd Welsh Escort Challenge 2007  
Overall Drivers and Co-Drivers

Points will be allocated to all registered\* drivers and co-drivers relative to their overall finishing positions on each event as follows: -

Highest placed registered Challenge contender	20
Second Highest placed registered Challenge contender	18
Third Highest placed registered Challenge contender	16
Fourth Highest placed registered Challenge contender	15
Fifth Highest placed registered Challenge contender	14

And so on down to the twentieth highest placed registered contender 01

(g) If there is more finisher's than these points allow for then every other finisher will be awarded a nominal one point.

The best Challenge Contender in each class on each event will receive 12 points, the next 10, then 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, and 1 point for tenth position. If there is more finisher's than these points allow for then every other finisher will be awarded a nominal one point.

Only points between Challenge Contenders count.

Maximum points in any drivers class will only be awarded provided a minimum of four registered\* drivers in that class start the event.

Maximum points in any co-drivers class will only be awarded provided a minimum of four registered\* co-drivers in that class start the event.

The best challenge contender in each class on an event where the minimum number of challenge contenders is not reached will receive 9 points, the next 7, down to 5 points for third. Points will only be awarded between Challenge registered contenders

(k) It is recommended that each competing vehicle in the Challenge carries two survival blankets (space blankets) to be available for use by the occupants in the event of breaking down in adverse weather conditions away from a position of immediate rescue.
